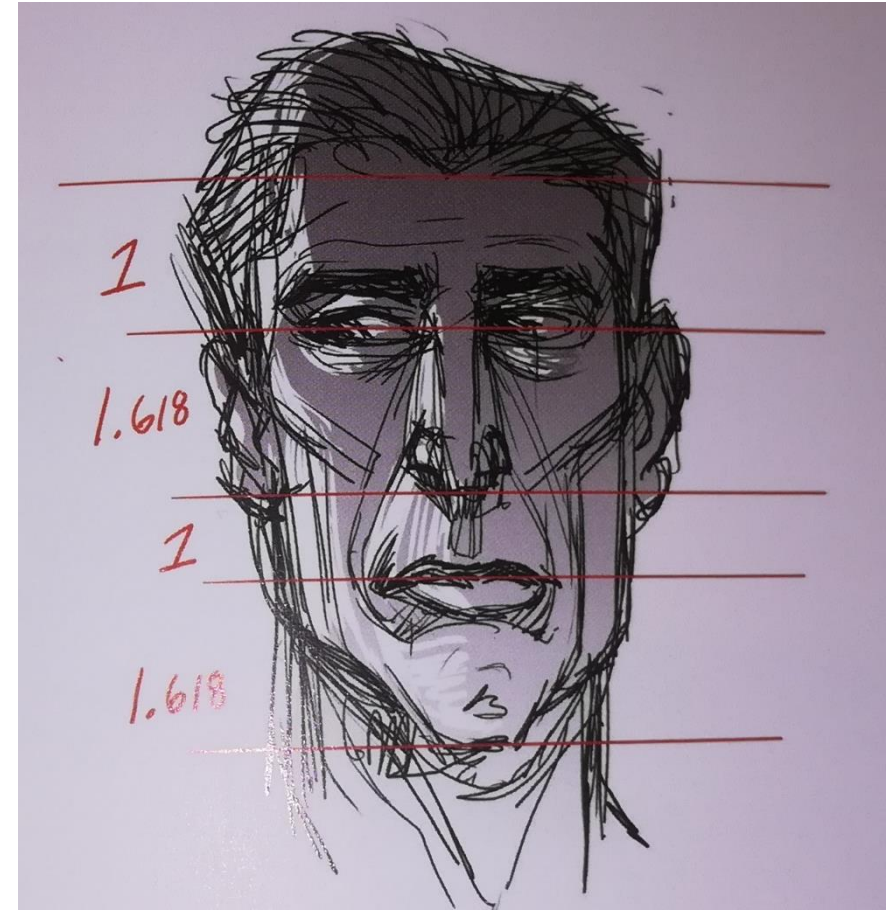


# Face Tips

- Don't get caught up in the details – create different face shapes
- Aim for clarity – think about definitive shapes
- Play with facial features to explore possibilities – where do you want your eyes to go?
- Vary the size of facial features for more energy and appeal
- Avoid the ladder and bowling ball – style evolves in finished piece but appeal begins in first stages of thought
- Apply golden ratio



# Face Tips

- Don't ignore negative space – define your shape format
- Push your shapes and angles – practice by drawing vase shapes
- Embrace rhythm – think about the planes that go in and out
- Pay attention to how heads move in real life – notice different shapes, tilts, arcs, and rhythms
- Avoid tangents – they confuse the viewer of special relationships
- Aim for harmony – repeat 2 or more elements in a design to unify drawing
