

Comic Review Journal

Directions: Each time that you read a comic, you will write a short comic review in your journal. On the left page of the journal you will list bullet pointed comments. On the right page, you will take those comments and write a concise, specific review of that comic in a single paragraph. Your review will focus on the comic elements discussed in class – panel layout, panel transitions, coloring, lettering, art style, etc.

Comic Review Journal Requirements:

1. Date on each entry: labeling each entry
2. Bullet-pointed review: brainstorming on left page
3. Review paragraph: analysis and evaluation of issue on right page

Comic Review Journal Rubric:

Comic Language	(10 pts) Student fluently uses multiple comic terms	(8-9 pts) Student correctly uses a couple comic terms	(6-7 pts) Student attempts to correctly use a couple comic terms	(0-5 pts) Student does not attempt to use comic terms or uses terms incorrectly
