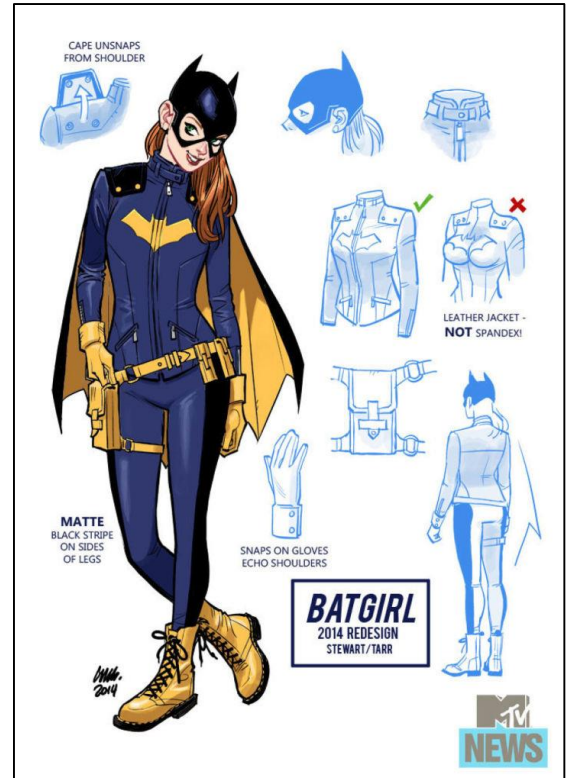


## Costume Redesign Project

**Directions:** Comic writers and artists often update characters by making changes to the character or story – one controversial change that often accompanies character redesigns are costumes. But, when creating or updating a costume, the artist and writer should have reasons for each choice. You will take an iconic character that you have been reading and studying and create a new costume that reflects the character’s personality as well as social changes.

### Costume Redesign Project Requirements:

1. Select a character that you like and know a lot about – someone that you have read stories about in class
2. List personality traits and provide evidence to support your claims
3. Research old costume designs and take notes on iconic symbols, colors, accessories, etc.
4. Identify outdated aspects of costume – make observations specific and thorough
5. Correct each outdated aspect, to reflect our current society
6. Write an explanation that clearly and thoroughly describes how your costume changes reflect society and how you maintain iconic components of the original costume
